Lipa was formed in 2000 in Omarska, Bosnia, at a time when the regions of Bosnia and Herzegovina were still subject to the multinational peacekeeping efforts of the NATO-led Stabilization Force (SFOR).

Beech lumber from Banja Luka, Bosnia is prized throughout the world for its clear consistent color - lacking in any "red heart" or center - and for its particularly stable fiber.

High quality Slavonian oak is also in strong supply, coming from the nearby Balkans region. Suppliers are chosen in accordance with rigid criteria regarding their reliability and trustworthiness - guaranteeing the highest level of conformity with industry regulations, and in furtherance of Lipa's commitment to sustainable forestry.

Respect and care for the environment, the responsibility of processing raw materials in accordance with quality standards, and knowledge obtained through years of experience are the elements which enable Lipa to compete and thrive in the internal and external markets


Mico was formed in 2001 and operates in Miercurea Sibiului near Sibiu, Romania in area of the Carpathian mountains - a renowned source of beech, ash and lime timber.

Mico is primarily dedicated to the acquisition of raw materials selected from providers who operate in conformity with the regulations and laws regarding harvesting and sustaining forests and woodlands. Mico has a singular constant objective: to become the premier Romanian source for high quality processed timber.

The reliable, continuous supply of timber, full control of the production cycle - from forest to sawn lumber, and the process of constant selection and monitoring to guarantee the highest quality finished product, are aspects of our operation which all share a common final aim: client satisfaction.

Corà Hardwood is a trading company located in Zagreb (Croatia), which specializes in the sale and distribution of oak and beech lumber.


